Would you fish in the restored estuary? We are currently assuming a pier for fishing. Are there considerations for that structure that would help it to be most effective in supporting this use?







Proposed boardwalks in Middle Basin and South Basin

Design Consideration:

The proposed boardwalks will be experienced (most often) as passing through tidal marsh habitat. Only under high water conditions will the boardwalks pass over open water.



QUESTION: We have been assuming programming for boardwalks for passive use only. Should we be considering other programming, such as active uses like fishing?






Let QUESTION: How can we design the boardwalks in such a way that recreationalists feel safe? (lighting, emergency response, active uses like fishing, etc.)

Marathon Park

- It is estimated that the channels in the North and Middle Basins would be inundated at depths that would support shallow-draft boating, such as kayaking, for approximately 70% of the daylight hours during the months of May through September
- In the summer, low tides occur most often during daylight hours


Water Depth (ft)









